Youth Financial Education Programme 2016 - Banking Perspective

Programme details:

"I am a Banker"

Form 4 and form 5 students from 25 secondary schools, who study Economics, Business, Accounting or Financial Management, will participate "I am a Banker" in groups. A workshop will be held on June 25 in which career planning counsellors from the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups (HKFYG) will brief students on the concepts of career planning while volunteers from the Hong Kong Association of Banks (HKAB) will talk about the structure and operations of the banking sector.

Three separate interactive sessions will be held in early July. Students will participate in a job guessing game by asking "Yes/No" questions to the "banker" volunteers. The volunteer will then share with the students in areas such as job natures, requirements and career path. Senior banking executives will also show up at the events and conduct a half-hour sharing on career-related topics.

Bank Visits

Hong Kong Association of Banks has invited 11 secondary schools to join the bank visits in October and November. Each school will select 30 students to take part in a half-day visit, which will be guided by bank staffs from HKAB's member banks. Social workers from the HKFYG will also facilitate discussion sessions after the events. Participants are required to share their experiences and what they have learnt at school assemblies or via board displays with fellow schoolmates.

Furthermore, the HKFYG will organize workshops in late September to mid-November in participating schools to introduce to students the concepts and importance of career planning.

Financial Education Workshops

Eight secondary schools will participate in the financial education workshops between September and November. Representatives from HKAB will give talk to about 50 students in each of the 90-minute session on financial knowledge. Student will also learn about different financial instruments and financial management principles by participating in interactive games to get prepared for joining the banking industry in the future.
